Charter

OF

The undersigned, citizens of the State of Kansas, do hereby voluntarily associate ourselves together for the purpose of forming a private corporation under the laws of the State of Kansas, and do hereby certify:

FIRST.

That the name of this corporation shall be THE Lyons Commercial Club.

SECOND.

That the purposes for which this corporation is formed are to that generally pertaining to a commercial club, to assemble and bring together the business men of the city of Lyons and the surrounding country for the purpose of promoting in a business and social way the interests of such city and surrounding country; for the purpose of getting into communication with various factories and other business concerns with a view of locating them in said city, for the purpose of giving any assistance to the city government that is deemed advisable; for the purpose of making improvements in said city and promoting the interests thereof and for all other purposes that may advance the interests of said city and the inhabitants thereof in a social, business, and athletic, ^{way} without profit of any kind or nature to said corporation; the said corporation being not organized for profit but purely for the above named purposes. Also to buy, sell, rent, encumber or otherwise dispose of any real estate or other property necessary to carry out the purposes for which this corporation is organized.

THIRD.

That the place where its business is to be transacted is at Lyons, Kansas.

FOURTH.

That the term for which this corporation is to exist is FIFTY YEARS.

FIFTH.

That the number of directors of this corporation shall be FIVE
and the names and residences of those who are appointed for the first year are:

That the amount of the capital stock of this corporation shall be
One hundred and fifty Dollars,
and shall be divided into One hundred and fifty shares,
of ONE Dollars each.

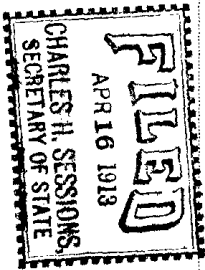
